HOW TO GET IN?

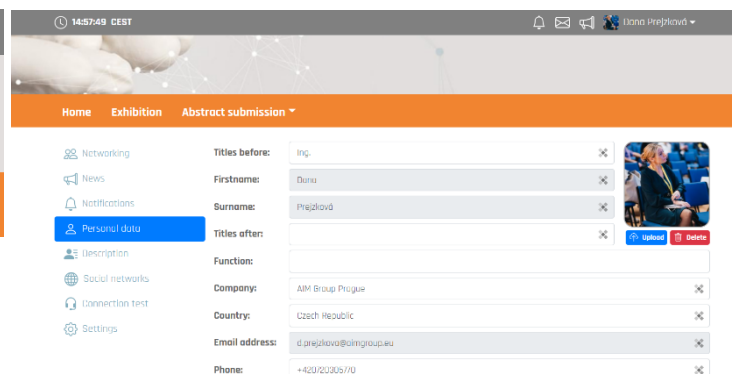
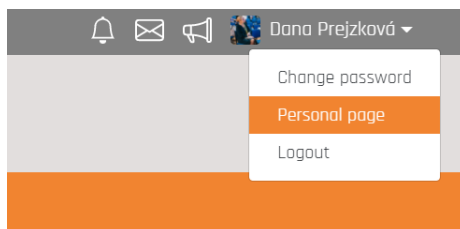
Use the “User login” button in the upper right corner of the [website](#):

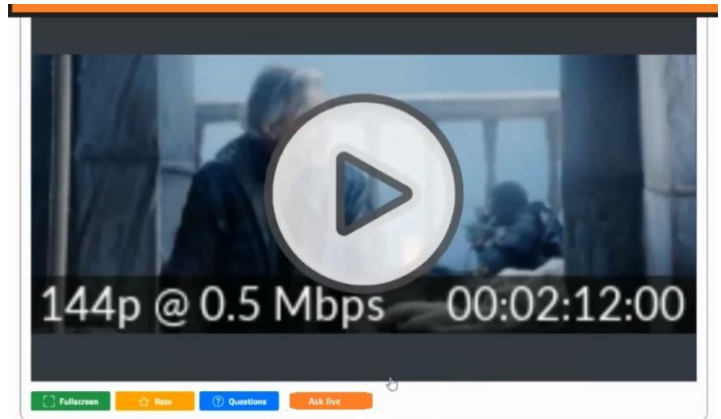


Questions & Answers Time
